

Begonia Whopper



Vigorous and heat tolerant with abundant flowers all summer; great plant to fill open shady spaces

Begonia sp. 'Whopper'

- **Use:** Very versatile and can be used in baskets, containers, garden beds, or in large landscape plantings. The favorite begonia of professionals and landscapers. So much better than regular begonias. Favorite begonia of landscapers and used most often in front of subdivisions.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 20-30" tall and 16-20" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant
- **Foliage:** Rounded, glossy leaves in green or dark red depending on cultivar. Red leaf types tolerate more sun.
- **Flower:** Produces extra large flowers up to 3 in. (7 cm) across from Spring through Fall...A must for creating 50 MPH drive-by color!
