## Caladium 'Freida Hemple'

- <u>Use:</u> This is a radiant container plant or summer border annual that's vigorous and carefree. Plants combine well with red Begonias and chartreuse Sweet Potato Vine. Caladiums thrive outdoors during the warmer months and add a lush, exotic touch to your yard or garden. They look fantastic in pots next to your shady front entrance or on the deck.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in partial sun to full shade. (Some pots marked as sun tolerant types.) Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results, but don't leave them in soggy areas or too much water— a sure recipe for death.
- **Growth**: Grows 1-2' tall depending on the amount you water and fertilize them.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-11 Annual /Houseplant
- *Foliage*: Molten red hearts are framed in wide green margins.
- Flower: Small spathe type flower. Not very noticeable.
