Calendula 'Bon Bon Orange'

- **Use:** Dwarf growing plants that will start blooming in two weeks. A good addition to the front border or used as an edging along a walkway.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Full sized plants grow to 10 inches tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone7-9; Treated as an Annual, because they dislike summer heat.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen
- **Flower:** Large globes of sunny orange flowers. Remove spent flower stems before they go to seed to promote new flower growth. Flower are excellent for cutting. "English Marigolds" are quite tolerant of frosts. Good at reseeding themselves.
