Calendula 'Lady Godiva Yellow'

- **Use:** Bright yellow flowers, historically used for medicinal and culinary purposes, come from easy calendula care when growing this simple flower. Commonly called the pot marigold, the calendula flower has long been a staple in British cottage gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun Must amend the soil if you have poor soil (like red clay). We recommend the Pro Mix Soil. Require different fertilizer than most plants as they grow in the winter. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer with Nitrate not Ammonium nitrogen form of fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Full sized plants grow to 10-14" inches tall and 13-16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Treated as an Annual, but they will reseed.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, Green foliage. Tolerant to powdery mildew
- **Flower:** Large colorful flowers with great heat tolerance. Fully double flowers means less seed set and fewer seedlings trying to take over your garden. Remove spent flower stems before they go to seed to promote new flower growth. Flower are excellent for cutting. "English Marigolds" are quite tolerant of frosts. Good at reseeding themselves.
