Calibrachoa 'Superbells Double Blue'

- **Use:** *I've been KNOWN to steal the GARDEN GNOME'S thunder.* Excellent used in beds, borders, hanging baskets, and containers. Lovely near your pool or water features. Low maintenance. Deer resistant and attracts hummingbirds.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves. If you are not good at watering get some **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-12" high and 20-30" trailing.
- **Hardiness:** Annual, Zone 9-11; Some people have luck with them coming back in the ground if mulched heavily in the winter. Will not come up until following May.
- **Foliage:** Dainty, green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Abundant, small double purplish-blue petunia-like flowers all season on cascading growth, no deadheading necessary.
