- <u>Use</u>: Fresh Look series offers so many advantages over older varieties it might as well be a new species. You'll get larger, brighter blooms and many more of them from well-branched plants; a super-long season of bloom; and a terrific adaptability to just about any climate and soil. Start designing your sunny beds and borders around this miraculous new Wheat Celosia today using this economical mix of all 4 colors: red, yellow, gold, and orange. Great cut flowers
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: Bewitching 14" tall and 12" wide plants create drama blazing away in the autumn landscape, mingling in the midborder, or unleashing a blast of color from a lucky patio container.
- *<u>Hardiness</u>: Zone* 9-11, Annual, Houseplant.
- *Foliage:* Fresh green foliage with a pointed tip. New leaves cover old plumes, so plants keep a fresh look all season.
- **<u>Flower:</u>** this variety is vigorous and blooms later, but puts on a fantastic show of color from late spring to early fall. Extra-large brilliant plumes are a lovely foil to the fresh green foliage. One of the longest blooming celosia on the market.
