## *Cleome hassleriana* 'Clio'

- **Use:** Great for use in flowerbeds, and large landscapes. Loved by hummingbirds and butterflies. This plant begins flowering in early summer (as soon as the hot weather arrives) and doesn't quit until the temperature drops in fall. A sun-lover, it is at home in the baking-hot border, bed, or patio, and once established is quite tolerant of dry conditions.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Quickly reaches 24 to 36 in. tall, spreading 18 to 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11 Annual, Many people have success with them reseeding and coming back every year.
- **Foliage:** The dark green foliage is narrow and stylish, too, making an attractive back drop for the big, fluffy blooms.
- **Flower:** They hold well on the plant and are wonderfully long-lasting as cutflowers. Tolerant of extreme heat, it is very uniformly sized and floriferous. In other words, a rare find! Sterile, so they bloom longer and faster.
