

Apollo Cosmos



Cosmos sulphureus 'Cosmic series' Red or Orange

- **Use:** Well-formed, large flowers build a rich canopy of color for best-in-class garden performance. Longer flowering. The overlapping petal arrangement of Apollo Mix cosmos causes flowers to be rounder, tidier, and longer-lasting than other cosmos. The dense and feathery, 18-26 in. tall plants branch freely to fill containers and garden beds with a long season of color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** It rapidly reaches 1-2 feet tall and about 1 1/2 feet wide. Great as an accent, poolside planting, or mid-border standout.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11 Annual, Many people have success with them reseeding and coming back every year.
- **Foliage:** Lacy leaves.
- **Flower:** A lively formulated mix of blush pink, purple, or white flowers. Each color in Apollo Mix has been awarded the prestigious 'Award of Garden Merit' by the Royal Horticultural Society.
