Diascia/ Dichondra 'Silver Falls'

- <u>Use:</u> Dichondra is a wonderful cascading plant. It does not flower but makes up for it with its nearly 2' of cascading silvery foliage that will make any window box or container look great. It can also be used as a ground cover.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full- part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Long silvery stems, sometimes reaching 4 feet or more, bear silvery, small leaves.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 10-11; Annual
- *Foliage:* Rounded fan shaped silver-stemmed foliage with a cascading habit.
- *Flower:* Does not flower.
