

# Mezoo Doreanthus



## *Dorotheanthus bellidiformis* 'Mezoo'

- **Use:** Mezoo Trailing Red is a great plant to add to any garden or floral environment. Its high versatility makes it a wise choice as a border or edging plant. Create beautiful potted combinations, hanging baskets, window boxes, and garden landscapes with trailing red as a unique accent plant. Trailing Red has vibrant red blooms that would be excellent in a patio container or as a feature plant in your home.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(5 or more hours). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to be slightly dry between waterings. Must have well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly and has a spread of 18-20 inches, requiring a space of 12-14 inches to properly grow and has an optimal height of 6-8 inches.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-10; Annual/ Possible tender perennial if very good drainage. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Has succulent green leaves with white edges.
- **Flower:** Features deep red-rose dime sized flowers that stay open during cloudy weather

A red pop of flower color sits among succulent green leaves with white edging. Loves a hot, sunny garden location.
