
Silver Mist Licorice Plant

Helichrysum microphyllum 'Silver Mist'

- <u>Uses</u>: Adds great contrast and texture to hanging baskets, containers and borders. It's silvery foliage is complementary in hanging baskets and containers with blues, purples, and burgundies and has a licorice fragrance, though it is not the true source. Nice in dried arrangements.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Prefers not to be overwatered.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and 18-20" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 7a-11; Tender Perennial/ Annual, Would need very good drainage in winter to be perennial
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Silvery soft leaves. Silver color intensifies with more light; under lower light, foliage appears more green.
- Flower: Not known for flowers.
