Impatiens 'Rockapulco Purple'

- <u>Use:</u> Light up any shady area with masses of blooms that resemble miniature rosebuds; no deadheading necessary, blooms spring to frost These shade lovers offer the perfect solution for those difficult to find blooming plants for locations.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (morning)-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 15-18" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- *Hardiness: Zone* 9-11, annual, houseplant
- *Foliage:* Small leaves. Downey mildew resistant foliage.
- <u>Flower:</u> The petite rosebud-like blooms are a stunning reddish-purple. Flowers continue to bloom in abundance from spring until frost, creating a knockout display of color.
