

New Guinea Impatiens



Impatiens hawkeri

- **Use:** Excellent in containers, hanging baskets or flower bed for a bright vivid splash of color!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in partial shade or shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry, don't let them dry out. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Brown leaf variety will tolerate more sun if the soil is not fantastic. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-15" tall and 15-18" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant
- **Foliage:** Green or red undersides of the leaf. We have found the red underside leaves to be more sun tolerant.
- **Flower:** Treasured for their neon eye-popping colors! They are just a great way to add instant pizzaz to a shady area.

Vigorous, upright plants with large flowers; great flowering color for shaded areas
