

Bright Ideas Lime Potato Vine



Plant with Zinnias, Coleus, or Wave Petunias for a stunning contrast in shape and texture.



Ipomea batatas 'Bright Ideas Lime'

- **Use:** Colorful, compact foliage is perfect for all season color and texture. Heat tolerant and durable. Try mixing with contrasting flowers and foliage in baskets and containers for a stunning display.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plants thrive in full sun or partial shade with consistent moisture. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** This plant has a short, mounded look that stays within a foot of the crown. Grows 12-18 inches tall with a spread of 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness: Zone 9-10 ;** Annual in this zone unless you dig up the potatoes and store them in the garage over winter.
- **Foliage:** Lime leaves leaves in sun, pale green in partial shade.
- **Flower:** Not very noticeable flowers.
