Ipomea batatas 'FloraMia Series'

- <u>Use:</u> Our interest in these Sweet Potatoes is not in the edible roots (which tend to be starchier than store bought types) but in the attractive foliage. Their large and colorful leaves cascade from containers in a seemingly endless stream all summer long, and their trailing habit makes them equally useful as striking, short-term ground covers or as skirts for upright plants.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plants thrive in full sun or partial shade with consistent moisture. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth**: Super fast grower trails only 4-8" tall and vigorous growth to 24-36" long vines of foliage.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-10 ; Annual in this zone unless you dig up the potatoes and store them in the garage over winter. Occasionally they will overwinter if good drainage in a mild winter.
- **Foliage:** Colorful foliage is the perfect foil for flowers and adds dramatic impact to containers.
- *Flower:* Not very noticeable flowers, but purple petunia like usually in late summer.
