

Flapjacks Kalanchoe



Makes a nice
houseplant.

Kalanchoe luciae

- **Use:** Appropriately nicknamed for the fleshy leaves that stack one on top of the other like pancakes. Drought and heat tolerant. Not frost hardy.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Water weekly allowing soil to dry out in between waterings. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. DO NOT OVERWATER!
- **Growth:** Grows slowly 1-2' tall and 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 11-12, Annual, houseplant, but also very happy outside in the full sun, just ease it out if it has been indoors so it doesn't get sunburned.
- **Foliage:** Forms a basal rosette of large, rounded, fleshy stalkless leaves. Gray-green with red margins.
- **Flower:** At maturity, the plant develops a spiky, dark yellow bloom.
