Plants are very floriferous and hold their mounded shape.

Lobelia 'Water Blue'

- **Use:** Very versatile and can be used in baskets, containers, garden beds, or in large landscape plantings. Good summer performance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. These newer types of Lobelia are much more heat tolerant than past plants. They will reliably bloom in warm temperatures unless night temperatures stay in the upper 70's or above. If you experience an extended time period with high night temperatures the plants may flush out of bloom, however, the plants themselves should continue to look good. If the plants do go out of flower using a sharp pair of scissors or pruning shears to give the plants a "haircut" - a slight overall trim - should encourage additional branching. Additional branching will result in increased flower power once the plants begin blooming again after night temperatures fall.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-15" and 12-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Delicate, but vibrant green foliage.
- **Flower:** A multitude of blossoms from spring to fall make this one of the landscape plants for high impact color! We love the lipped flowers!
