

Calliope Lavender Rose Geranium



Pelargonium 'Calliope' Lavender Rose

- **Use:** An indispensable geranium, a welcome addition to any garden. Best-performing geranium produces a floral cavalcade of big, beautiful lavender-rose blooms right through the summer. Beautiful peak-performance plants can take it all: thriving in high heat, humidity, and drought. Versatile, mounding 12-14" plants with semi-double, lavender-rose flowers, cool-green ivy foliage, and trailing habit, add instant magic to window boxes, hanging baskets and containers. Deadheading insures a steady stream of luscious blooms from late spring into autumn. Resilient variety quickly rebounds from summer downpours. Breakthrough plant is a cross between a zonal geranium and an ivy geranium, representing the best features of both.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week, but may need daily watering with 90 degree plus temps. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 16-20" tall and 14-20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Dainty, green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Very large double rose-lavender blossoms from spring until fall frosts. Deadheading insures a steady stream of luscious blooms from late spring into autumn.
