

Moxie! Geranium



Plants have excellent branching, good heat tolerance, and compact to medium vigor. They flower all season long and are ideal for medium-size containers or in the ground.



Pelargonium 'Moxie! Series'

- **Use:** Mounded, densely branched habits deliver superior flower coverage all season long. Moxie is the first and only interspecific geranium bred for brilliant color in small containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week, but may need daily watering with 90 degree plus temps. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Will grow to be about 12-14 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 20 inches. When grown in masses or used as a bedding plant, individual plants should be spaced approximately 16 inches apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Its tomentose round palmate leaves remain green in color with prominent brown stripes throughout the year.
- **Flowers:** Clusters of flowers from spring until late fall frosts. In our trials we have found this series to produce the lots flowers in the summer heat of Georgia while not getting too leggy. (Shorter and more compact than Calliope)
