Pelargonium 'Savannah Series'

- **Use:** Outstanding performer and super beauty, resilient variety quickly rebounds from summer downpours. Happily immune to heat, humidity and drought. A fine choice for the garden, but it is also a good selection for planting in outdoor containers and hanging baskets. With its upright habit of growth, it is best suited for use as a 'thriller' in the 'spiller-thriller-filler' container combination; plant it near the center of the pot, surrounded by smaller plants and those that spill over the edges.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week, but may need daily watering with 90 degree plus temps. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Will grow to be about 20 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 20 inches. When grown in masses or used as a bedding plant, individual plants should be spaced approximately 16 inches apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Its tomentose round palmate leaves remain green in color with prominent brown stripes throughout the year.
- **Flowers:** Clusters of flowers from spring until late fall frosts. In our trials we have found this series to produce the most flowers in the summer heat of Georgia.
