Pelargonium 'Survivor Series'

- **Use:** These zonal geraniums give an outstanding show throughout the summer to the first frosts of autumn. Extremely free flowering, they produce large flower heads in an assortment of bright and bicolored shades creating an impressive display in pots, planters and borders. A true survivor, this geranium withstands the weather with a blaze of gorgeous blooms.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week, but may need daily watering with 90 degree plus temps. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Remove spent flowers and the whole stem. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Will grow to be about 18 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 18 inches. When grown in masses or used as a bedding plant, individual plants should be spaced approximately 16 inches apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Houseplant
- **Foliage:** Its tomentose round palmate leaves remain green throughout the year.
- **Flowers:** A reliable performer with bright, large-headed flowers throughout the summer in an explosion of color shades.
