

Caliburst Yellow Petchoa



Petchoa x "Caliburst Yellow"

- **Use:** A remarkable cross between petunia and calibrachoa is the first Petchoa you can grow from seed. Blooming over three seasons, 'Caliburst Yellow's blooms resemble petunias in size, shape and saturated color. Mounded, spreading habit creates a joyous golden splash in containers, pots and hanging baskets. Serves prettily as groundcover or edging.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week under the leaves. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves. Detests too much rain or overhead water sprinklers that go off too late in the day. If you are not good at watering get some **Soil Moist granules to add to soil.**
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 6-10" high and 20-24" trailing.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Some people have luck with them coming back in the ground if mulched heavily in the winter. Will not come up until following May however. Excellent heat tolerance and weather recovery.
- **Foliage:** Dainty, green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Blooms a full 3 seasons, from early spring through autumn. Free and continuously flowering, this petchoa creates a canopy of color with large, showy, vibrant yellow blooms that are prettily ruffled and long lasting.
