- <u>Use</u>: *A new cross between a Petunia and the Calibrachoa (Million bells).
 Loves full sun and trails nicely. Coved with more flowers than you can count!
 Excellent used in beds, borders, hanging baskets, and containers. Lovely
 near your pool or water features. Low maintenance. Deer resistant and attracts hummingbirds. Enjoy SuperCal's strong vigor and good disease tolerance in the garden. Blooms leave no sticky residue for easier handling.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week under the leaves. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves. Detests too much rain or overhead water sprinklers that go off too late in the day. If you are not good at watering get some **Soil Moist granules to add to soil**.
- Growth: Moderate grower 10-14 high and 12-20" trailing.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-11; Tender perennial, Some people have luck with them coming back in the ground if mulched heavily in the winter. Will not come up until following May however. Excellent heat tolerance and weather recovery.
- Foliage: Dainty, green leaves.
- Flowers: A profusion of cascading, small petunia-like flowers all season. They come in over 20+ colors.
