- <u>Use:</u> The unique neon colors and superb habits of the Hells series have created a tremendous amount of interest from growers and gardeners. With a vigorous, horizontal branching habit, these plants fill up baskets fast. And as for color, we can't say enough! The blooms are the brightest we've ever seen and completely cover every bit of the plants from side to side. Contains A1DFR Gene.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week under the leaves. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves. Detests too much rain or overhead water sprinklers that go off too late in the day. If you are not good at watering get some Soil Moist granules to add to soil.
- <u>Growth</u>: Moderate grower 6-8" high and 12-18" trailing.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9-11; Annual/Tender perennial, Some people have luck with them coming back in the ground if mulched heavily in the winter. Will not come up until following May however. Excellent heat tolerance and weather recovery.
- Foliage: Dainty, green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Perhaps the most vibrant red petunia, 'Hells Ember Red' is an almost neon-red with dark centers, that is sure to pop in your landscape.
