

Limbo™ Series Petunia



Limbo is designed for small space gardens such as urban residences or formal gardens requiring neat, tidy plants. At 4 inches or larger, Limbo blooms are huge but recover quickly from severe weather. Plants are virtually maintenance-free, no pinching needed.

- **Use:** Great for use in containers, flowerbeds, and large landscapes. Loved by hummingbirds. Petunia Limbo has large, Grandiflora-sized flowers that cover a dwarf plant habit, and when other petunias stretch, the Limbos will not. All of the colors in the series put on impressive, easy-care shows in pots, beds and mass plantings throughout the Summer, right up until fall frost.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** The ultimate plant size is only 6 to 7 inches tall, spreading 10 to 12 inches.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b-11 Annual, Many people have success with them re-seeding and coming back every year. Can handle light frosts above 26 degrees.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Trumpet-shaped flowers that are 4+ inches across. The Limbo™ Series deliver large blooms and an even plant growing habit among all the colors in the series. They come in a wide variety of bright colors and do well from early spring until late fall.
