Petunia 'Supertunia Black Cherry'

- <u>Use:</u> I'm EASYGOING, no need to FUSS with me. Supertunia petunias are vigorous with slightly mounded habits that function as both fillers and spillers in containers. They are also excellent landscape plants, best suited to be placed near the front of beds. They have medium to large sized flowers.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- <u>Growth:</u> So in a garden bed, border, or landscape feature we grow 6-12" inches tall, and spread w-a-a-y out. As much as 2.5 feet. You want to fill an area with wall-to-wall medium pink flowers all season? I'm your plant. Hanging baskets, window boxes, patio containers, same story.
- Hardiness: Zone 10-11 Annual,
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. It's pointy leaves remain green in color throughout the season.
- <u>Flower:</u> How deep can red flowers get? And how easy can they be to plant and grow? Find out with Supertunia Black Cherry Petunia. These best-selling petunias have it all, including deep red color with even redder, nearly black, accents. The flowers appear all summer with no deadheading or other effort except watering.
