- **Use:** Supertunia Vista petunias are one of the best garden plants around. They are large, mounding and spreading plants. They are usually so buried in flowers that foliage is almost invisible. They are wonderful landscape plants, where they put on quite a show. They are also great in large containers. If you are looking for an all out show of color, this is the plant for you.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Standing 12-24 inches tall and spreading to 36 inches wide, this is a Petunia that is a workhorse, one plant covers a lot of ground.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-11 Annual,
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It's pointy leaves remain green in color throughout the season.
- **Flower:** Features large, bright fuchsia purple color blooms from early spring until frosts. Self cleaning blooms.
