Petunia 'Supertunia Royal Magenta'

- **Use:** **FANCY, yet UNFUSSY.** Supertunia petunias are vigorous with slightly mounded habits that function as both fillers and spillers in containers. They are also excellent landscape plants, best suited to be placed near the front of beds. They have medium to large sized flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** So in a garden bed, border, or landscape feature we grow 6-10" tall, and spread w-a-a-y out. As much as 48" wide. You want to fill an area with wall-to-wall medium pink flowers all season? I'm your plant. Hanging baskets, window boxes, patio containers, same story.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10a-11b Annual,
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It's pointy leaves remain green in color throughout the season. If your plant begins to look open or a bit tired, an allover trim can be beneficial. Use a sharp pair of scissors or pruning shears to trim back up to 1/3 of the volume of the plant.
- **Flower:** deep hot pink blooms with a dark purple center that will bring a pop of color to your garden. SUPERTUNIA® ROYAL MAGENTA® Petunia blooms continuously, does not need to be deadheaded, has wonderful fragrance, and will attract butterflies and hummingbirds to your garden.
