

Lemon Twist Swedish Ivy



Plectranthus 'Lemon Twist'

- **Use:** Contrasting, felty-textured leaves scalloped with lemon yellow on upright, shrubby, mounded plant. Has a nice lemon scent to the foliage. Very attractive in hanging baskets, containers, or borders. Attractive variety grown primarily for its green and lemon yellow variegated foliage; mounded form should be occasionally trimmed to maintain shape; a lovely addition to the garden or containers; heat tolerant
- **Exposure/Soil:** Very easy to grow with relatively low maintenance. Plant in full sun, partial sun, or full shade; heat tolerant. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results, but don't leave them in soggy areas or too much water.
- **Growth:** Height can reach 8-10" while the spread is 18-30".
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11 Annual; Houseplant Heat tolerant.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous unless taken indoors. Attractive serrated heart-shaped leaves emerge chartreuse in spring, turning green in color with distinctive yellow edges the rest of the year.
- **Flower:** Neither the flowers nor the fruit are ornamentally significant.

Loves the sun or part shade and super easy! Can also be used as an easy houseplant for a sunny window.
