Salvia sp. 'Mojave Series'

- **Use:** Strength and Beauty The absolute best option for landscape performance. Excellent heat tolerance, branching and repeat flowering. Low profile, densely formed flower spikes and dark foliage provide excellent contrast in the garden. These are so easy to grow in full/part sun and they attract hummingbirds and butterflies and bloom non-stop all summer until frost.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow 8-12" tall. Plant 10-12" apart.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11 Annual Heat tolerant.
- **Foliage:** Fragrant, green leaves. Pinch back tips and old flowers occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Flower spikes are a nonstop profusion of color from May until late October!

Attracts hummingbirds and loves the heat!
