

# Bombay Compact Dark Blue Fan Flower



## *Scaveola 'Bombay Compact Dark Blue'*

- **Use:** The flower-encrusted, cascading branches of scaevola make it an ideal choice for window boxes, hanging baskets, or tall containers where it's trailing form can flow over the container's edge. Lovely blue near your pool or water features.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Loves full sun or at least 4-5 hours of afternoon sun. They love the heat! Water 2-3 times a week. Try to keep water off of the leaves. Requires well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly under the leaves. If you are not good at watering get some **Soil Moist**.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower 8-14" high and 20-24" trailing.
- **Hardiness:** Annual, houseplant
- **Foliage:** Dainty, green leaves.
- **Flowers:** Delicate dark blue small fans are loved for their ability to attract butterflies!
