Senecio 'Cirrus'

- <u>Use</u>: Grown for its attractive silver-gray foliage and mounding form. Can over winter and act like a perennial in warmer areas, or if mulched heavily. Perfect accent perfect for pots, mixed baskets and the front of the border. Year round interest and lovely used in the winter with pansies or with petunias in summer.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun-part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in.
 of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-12" tall and 8-12" wide, Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 7-11, Perennial; We have had ours in the yard for over 4 years; Just cut them back once a season.
- *Foliage:* Evergreen; Silvery, greenish-white, elliptic, lobed leaves. We love using the leaves in small cutflower mixed arrangements
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, flowers are mustard-yellow, held in corymbs, and are produced in the second year.
