Senecio 'Quicksilver'

- **Use:** Quicksilver has a natural dwarf plant habit and stays more dwarf than Silverado or older Silverdust. A great accent in garden beds, hanging baskets, and planters. Year round interest and lovely used in the winter with pansies or with petunias in summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-10" tall and 8-10" wide, Use in patio containers, hanging baskets and beds
- **Hardiness:** 7-11, Perennial; We have had ours in the yard for over 4 years; Just cut them back once a season.
- **Foliage:** The silver foliage of this plant is an excellent accent in the garden.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are yellow.
