## *Solenostemon scutellarioides* 'Colorblaze Chocolate Drop'

- **Use:** ColorBlaze Chocolate Drop displays rounded green leaves with a deep crimson center. It is heat tolerant, resists deer, and deadheading is not necessary. It is also adaptable as a houseplant, place in a bright area. Fabulous for pots, hanging baskets, and window boxes with its modest size.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– shade (less color on leaves in shade), very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 14-20 inches tall and 18-24 inches wide at maturity
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-11, Annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Lobed, rounded green leaves have a deep crimson center and crimson venation.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
