

Colorblaze Rediculous Coleus



The upright habit of Coleus COLORBLAZE® REDICULOUS™ make this a great thriller for container designs as well as adding an upright splash of color to the landscape. We recommend fertilizing annuals with a water soluble fertilizer to keep them looking fabulous all summer into the fall.

Solenostemon/Plectranthus scutellarioides 'Colorblaze Rediculous'

- **Use:** Adds a high impact of color to your planters. The deep magenta/burgundy foliage adds a great pop of color, mix with other coleus for a dramatic display. The more sun it gets the more prominent the burgundy color.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– shade (less color on leaves in shade), very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens. If you are in an area with low humidity we recommend planting in part shade to full shade.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 24-40" tall or more and about 30-40" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-10, Annual or Houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations with good drainage, but that depends on the winter.
- **Foliage:** Cutting grown. Burgundy foliage from spring until fall, it really shows off in fall against mums and pumpkins.
- **Flower:** If flowers start to form or if your plant is getting taller than desired, we recommend pinching it back to your desired height. The plant will in turn produce more foliage for a fuller looking plant.
