- **Use:** boldly-patterned, juicy red-orange serrated foliage makes a red-hot impression in full sun or shade. This strong and fast growing annual deserves to be the highlight of your summer garden. These new, bigger, sun loving varieties have revolutionized container gardening, and also tolerate some shade. The dark foliage adds a great contrast to brightly colored flowers. Durable and easy to grow, they quickly put on a massive display during the summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun – shade (less color on leaves in shade) Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 2-3' tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-11, Annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Bolder than Campfire. Saturated orange coloration and textured leaves give it a WOW factor. Superior orange coloration and later-flowering than the competition. More consistent orange color, even in shady conditions.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small bluish flowers on stalks in fall.
