- **Use:** Redhead was awarded Best Coleus at the Cornell floral trials, for a good reason, as it is a vigorous grower, uniform, and with a unique, vibrant color that glows! These new, bigger, sun loving varieties have revolutionized container gardening. Also tolerates some shade. The brilliant colors explode in sunny locations. Coleus plants are durable and easy to grow. Grows quickly and puts on a massive display during the summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun – shade (less color on leaves in shade) Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 18-36" tall or more and 16-28" wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-10, Annual or Houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** bright, red leaves with serrated pointy leaves.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
