

Great falls Angel Sun Coleus



Solenostemon scutellarioides 'Great Falls Angel'

- **Use:** Planter perfection is yours with this easy-to-grow eye-catching trailing coleus. Named after the great waterfalls of the world, these coleus with their bold, nonfading foliage colors and dense small leaves are very heat tolerant. The well behaved growing plants add architectural interest and mix phenomenally in planters & baskets with other flowers or foliage or are attractive enough to grow all by themselves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** This Coleus will take full sun or partial shade so it will brighten almost any spot in the garden (less color on leaves in shade). Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 8" tall or more and 3' wide
- **Hardiness:** 9-10, annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Beautiful colored foliage in a mix of pink, green, and purple with a touch of yellow.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
