Solenostemon scutellarioides 'Mainstreet Series'

- **Use:** Grow stunning patterns and colors anywhere, shade or sun! With outstanding performance this vigorous grower is low maintenance but makes a high impact in the garden. Coleus adds a variety of contrast and texture to any container or landscape planting with its unique foliage. Fabulous for pots, hanging baskets, and window boxes with its modest size. Cutting grown. Great heat tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Though most tolerate full sun, they are more valuable in shade, where summer color is scarce. However, the more sun you give them the more brilliant the leaves. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 12-18" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-11; Annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Chartreuse leaves.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
