

Stained Glass Wedding Train Sun Coleus



Solenostemon scutellarioides 'Wedding Train'

- **Use:** Distinctive “wedding train” trailing habit, dark color and unique texture are great for shade containers and baskets. Hardy until frost and thrives in the heat.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Though most tolerate full sun, they are more valuable in shade, where summer color is scarce. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly 10-12” tall or more and 2-3’ wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-10; Annual or houseplant, some people have luck with them coming back in sheltered locations
- **Foliage:** Small-leaved, creeping Coleus Burgundy Wedding Train adds rich color to containers and hanging baskets. The dark maroon leaves are outlined in chartreuse, and the plant has a creeping, trailing habit.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers, but they are small flowers on purple stalks in fall.
