Sutera cordata

- **Use:** Use in hanging baskets, window boxes and landscaping. Vigorous grower with white blooms all season. Attracts Butterflies and deadheading is not necessary
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun-partial shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. To keep constantly wet, we recommend SOIL MOIST granules.
- **Growth:** Will continue to grow in the basket. Occasional pinching may be necessary to contain growth if getting too large.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant
- **Foliage:** Small fragrant foliage.
- **Flower:** A multitude of blossoms from spring to fall make this one of the landscape plants for high impact color! Unlike most plants, sutera will not wilt when drought stressed and will drop flowers. Companion plants such as petunias and begonias will serve as indicator plants to let you know that the sutera is dry.
