- **Use:** Very free-blooming, Janie Yellow Marigold is a great choice for the front of the border, edging, and containers of all types. Even effective as a nematode-repellent in the vegetable garden. And the blooms really bring in the butterflies. Very heat-tolerant with good garden vigour in warmer temperatures.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** The compact plant size—just 8 –10 inches tall and 6-10 inches across.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Treated as an annual or houseplant in our area. You may keep seed for following year.
- **Flower:** Continuing to bloom until fall frost, these sunny, 2-inch blooms drape the dwarf 8- to 10-inch plants in a soft mantle.
