Marigolds are a great companion plant for pretty much all garden plants, blooming or edible. Their roots contain thiopene which is toxic to certain nematodes. Plant marigolds around the outside of your garden to discourage aphids and beetles from stopping by for and all you can eat smorgasbord.

Tagetes patula 'Super Hero Series'

- **Use:** A lovely compact French marigold with unreal uniformity and stable colors. Stunning 2" blooms make any garden fit for a Super Hero! ... Longer blooming compared to African types, gardeners enjoy flowers up through frost. Ideal to use as edging in flower beds, mass plantings, and containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- **Growth:** The compact plant size—just 8 to 10" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Treated as an annual, houseplant in our area
- **Flower:** The gorgeous double flowers are one of the largest flowering dwarf French Marigolds with a diameter of 2-2.5" No deadheading needed.
