

Purple Sensation Onion



- **Planting density:** 3 per sq ft.
- **Planting depth:** 3-5 inches to base of the bulb.
- **Best planted in a mass for dramatic effect.**



Allium 'Purple Sensation'

- **Use:** This is the earliest of the large-flowered Alliums and also among the most affordable. Outstanding with silver foliage, and with Bearded Irises or Ladies' Mantle (Alchemilla) Deer and rodent resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of sun) . Well-drained sandy soil. Tolerates summer drought, but should be kept moist during growing season.
- **Growth:** Grows 24-32” tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Reddish violet balls 4-5in across are borne on 20-30in stems in late spring.
