

Amadeus Candy Amaryllis



Amaryllis hippeastrum 'Amadeus Candy'

- **Use:** This huge, romantic bloom has ruffly, flouncy petals of glistening white with tips that are softly brushed in raspberry to pink. The shapely blooms and rich, iridescent colors of Amaryllis light up a cold day like nothing else we know. Each bulb will produce at least 2 stems and a total of 8+ flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** The bulb will send out more stalks of flowers and grower larger over time. **Ask cashier for a handout on care.**
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 7-10** Perennial Herbaceous.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** An elegant ivory variety with soft pink accents at the tip of each velvety petal. This is an uncommonly pretty, unique amaryllis that celebrates its exotic beauty by bearing double the petals for double the enjoyment. Blooms 8-10 weeks after planting.
