Hippeastrum (Amaryllis) 'Amarantia'

- **Use:** Enjoy an explosion of fresh winter blooms with Amaryllis. Festive blooms atop strong stems will give you flowers perfect for the holidays and all winter long. Each bulb will produce at least 2 stems and a total of 8 flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** The bulb will send out more stalks of flowers and grower larger over time. **Ask cashier for a handout on care.**
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7/8-10 Perennial Herbaceous.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Large double blooms give off diva vibes. The lavishly layered, rich red petals reflex gracefully, and the blossoms hold their heads up well.
