

# Artic Nymph Amaryllis



## *Amaryllis hippeastrum* 'Artic Nymph'

- **Use:** This easy-to-grow bulb is a real gem! Our bulbs are larger than most other stores which means more flowers! Plant 7 weeks before Christmas to enjoy flowers for the holidays! Amaryllis are perennials here in Georgia and come back every year with more and larger flowers each summer! Our premium Dutch bulbs are selected for their size, beauty and reliability. Each bulb will produce at least 2 stems and a total of 8 flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** Compact type to about 1-1.5' tall
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 Perennial Herbaceous.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Glacial white with hints of green deep inside, the fully double blooms of 'Arctic Nymph' are not only large (to 7" across) but carried on sturdy stems. This winter white will be stylish anywhere. Allow 8–10 weeks from bulb to bloom, but can vary depending on your conditions.
