Amaryllis hippeastrum 'Cherry Nymph'

- **Use:** This easy-to-grow bulb is a real gem! Our bulbs are larger than most other stores which means more flowers! Plant 7 weeks before Christmas to enjoy flowers for the holidays! Amaryllis are perennials here in Georgia and come back every year with more and larger flowers each summer! Our premium Dutch bulbs are selected for their size, beauty and reliability. Each bulb will produce at least 2 stems and a total of 8 flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant when established, but prefers moist soil, but must be well-drained.
- **Growth:** The non-invasive stems spread out to 3' wide each season.
- **Hardiness:** 7-10 Perennial Herbaceous.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Long, strap-like leaves.
- **Flower:** Produces huge, almost fully double flowers whose rich texture and colors set new standards of beauty for this elegant genus. The large red blooms of 'Cherry Nymph' have a shimmering, iridescent quality, and its thick, strong stems easily support them
