## White Glory of the Snow



- Planting density: 2
  -3 inch apart, 10
  per sq. ft.
- Planting depth: 5 inches to base of the bulb.
- Best planted in a mass of 60 or more for dramatic effect.





## Chionodoxa luciliae 'Alba'

- <u>Use:</u> Great naturalizers in rock and woodland gardens or in lawns; 'shoes and socks' plant for larger daffodils, tulips and hyacinths; late winter/early spring; Seeds itself freely to create lovely carpets. Great with early Narcissus, such as 'Tete-a-Tete'. Deer resistant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-part sun (does best with some afternoon shade). Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 6-10" tall.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-8. Perennial. Bulb.
- Foliage: Deciduous.
- Flower: Pure white 5-10 small starry flowers in a spray per stem in late winter/early spring;
