

Dorothy Crocus



- **Planting density: 3-4 inch apart, 10 per sq. ft.**
- **Planting depth: 3-4 inches to base of the bulb.**
- **Best planted in a mass of 60 or more for dramatic effect.**

Crocus 'Dorothy'

- **Use:** Brighten up dull winter gardens and lawns with these early flowering crocus bulbs, they have pretty bright yellow flowers that are striped with bronze on the outside. Snow crocuses naturalize well and gently spread over time. Excellent planted with early blooming crocus Advance. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Grows 1-4" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4 –8 Bulb. Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small grass-like foliage.
- **Flower:** Dainty goblet shaped flowers in light yellow, shaded bronzy on the outer petals.
